1st Nov From Where I Sat *Rosemary Riddell LLB, LTCL*

Rosemary will speak about her years as a judge, the highs and the lows, the funny and the sad, the hopeful and the hopeless. The parade of people that Rosemary dealt with on a daily basis gave her a unique insight into human nature and, from that experience, Rosemary will set out her own views on how the justice system should be changed or modified.

8th Nov The History of Frontal Lobotomy. *Professor Michael Colombo PhD*

In my talk I will trace the history of frontal lobotomy from the early studies of Egas Moniz to the later dramatic work of Walter Freeman. I will discuss the conditions that gave rise to this dramatic procedure, and the conditions that eventually led to its demise in the 1950s.

15th Nov The Beatles: A Short History in Four Parts *Assoc Prof Robert Burns PhD*

To cover the career of what might be regarded as the most influential pop group in the twentieth century in an hour would be impossible. However, I have chosen four pivotal eras in which the band made changes to their image and sound, song writing, business structure, and their ultimate demise.
